### Three simple steps to identify your first AI automation.

Every business has processes that eat hours of manual work every week. This self-assessment helps you pick the right one to automate with AI in three simple steps, taking less than 20 minutes.

1. Identify the process with the greatest AI opportunity.
2. Map the process and identify the friction and opportunity.
3. Estimate what AI automation could save you in real dollars.

When you're done, you'll have a clear view of your AI automation opportunity.

STEP 1: IDENTIFY YOUR PROCESS

### Find the process with the highest automation potential.

Use the table below to list processes in which your team spends time on repetitive manual work. These could include order processing, customer onboarding, report generation, data entry, or compliance checking. Whatever they are, they should happen regularly and follow a roughly consistent pattern.

For each process, check which of the five automation signals apply. The more signals a process matches, the stronger the automation case.

- Data Entry:** Your team manually moves information between systems, copies data from emails into a CRM, rekeys figures from one spreadsheet to another, or enters form data into a database.
- Document Processing:** Your team reads documents to pull out specific information, such as scanning invoices for amounts, reviewing applications for fields, extracting contract terms, or classifying data.
- Verification:** Your team verifies data against known standards, such as matching names across records, confirming totals, checking required fields, or flagging items outside acceptable thresholds.
- Routing:** The bottleneck is getting the right information to the right person at the right time: assigning work, escalating issues, sending status updates, or triggering the next step in a workflow.
- Reporting:** Your team assembles reports by pulling data from multiple sources, formatting it, and summarizing results. Weekly status reports, month-end reconciliations, compliance summaries, or management dashboards that require manual compilation.

**EXAMPLE**

**New policy application intake example**

Here’s how a typical policy intake workflow breaks down at a small insurance brokerage. Use this as an idea for mapping your own process.

**STEP 3: ESTIMATE YOUR SAVINGS**

## Calculate what this process costs you today.

This worksheet calculates the labor cost of your process and provides a savings range. Estimates are fine where exact numbers aren't available.

<b>A. Monthly volume (how many times per month)</b> <i>How many times does your team complete this process per month?</i>	
<b>B. Minutes per completion</b> <i>Total minutes from your Step 2 time column.</i>	
<b>C. Loaded hourly rate</b> <i>Base salary ÷ 2,080 hours, then add 30% for benefits.</i>	\$

<b>D. Monthly hours = A × B ÷ 60</b> <i>Multiply volume by minutes, then divide by 60 to convert to hours.</i>

<b>Conservative estimate (60% of F)</b> <i>If only the most routine steps are automated.</i>	\$

Realistic AI automation typically recovers 60% to 90% of labor costs, depending on how much of the process is fully versus partially automated. The conservative end assumes only the most routine steps are automated. The aggressive end assumes the full workflow is handled by AI with human oversight on exceptions only.

### Where do you reallocate the reclaimed time and expense?

Automation directly reduces labor cost, and that reduction is the core ROI. What your team does with the reclaimed time can increase that return further. Think about three destinations for the hours you reclaim.

- Revenue-producing work.** Sales outreach, customer acquisition, retention, upselling. If your team is spending hours on data entry instead of talking to customers, this reallocation case is obvious.
- Higher-value operational work.** Complex cases, exception handling, strategic projects, quality improvement. The work that requires judgment and currently gets squeezed by routine tasks.
- Innovation and improvement.** New products, better customer experiences, process improvements, or strategic initiatives that never get prioritized because the team is buried in routine work.
